



PTSO Meeting was held December 9, 2021 in Pershing's Media Center

Meeting was called to order at 4:11pm

The meeting began with the approval of minutes from the last PTSO meeting held on October 27, 2021. Stacy made a motion to approve the minutes. Brie seconded the approval. No one opposed.

Treasurer's Report

- Rebecca reviewed the October/November 2021 Treasurer Reports. Total revenues for November were \$29,621.21; total expenses for November were \$1,766.87. The ending book balance as of November 30, 2021 was \$44,659.18. The Chipotle sprit night brought in \$300 in revenue. Concessions for November brought in \$409.00.
- The Board voted to amend the budget line for 5th/8th grade celebrations. Currently the celebrations are listed together as one budget line item. The Board voted to make one line for each going forward. The total amount for each grade level celebrations will be \$1000.

Membership Report

- December's Parent Engagement Meeting went well. Deputy Roman introduced herself and allowed time for Q & A. Future topics in early 2022 could be focused around clubs and testing.
- Brie provided an update on grade level reps. They are now in the system. There is good representation among the various grades. There is one lead per grade which is the primary contact.

Communications Report

- Rachael is coordinating selling spirit shirts after Winter Break.

Fundraising Report

- The updated Spirit Night Calendar is as follows:

- o March, April, and May are open. Gatlin Brewery is still a possibility to host a spirit night.
- Czarina reported on the following:
 - o The Raise Craze Fall Fundraiser brought in \$28,000+ dollars. This well exceeded the initial projected revenue of \$15,000.

- There continues to be a need for volunteers at concessions during volleyball home games. There will be upcoming volunteer needs in 2022 for other sports. More to come.

- The revised PTSO Bylaws were reviewed. These can be approved at the January meeting.
