### **Meeting was called to order at 4:06pm**

The meeting began with the approval of minutes from the last PTSO meeting held on September 30, 2021. Rachael made a motion to approve the minutes. Rebecca seconded the approval. No one opposed.

### **Treasurer's Report**

- Rebecca reviewed the September 2021 Treasurer's Report. Total revenues YTD was \$15,644.37; total expenses YTD was \$3,079.01. The ending book balance as of September 30, 2021 was \$9,062.21.
- Receivables for September were \$3,089.06 (Spirit Store), \$55.00 (Concessions), \$1000.00 (Business Sponsorships), and \$838.90 (Mooyah's Spirit Night).
